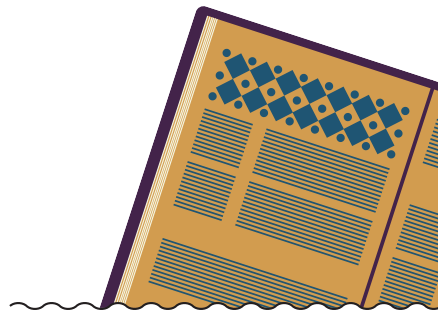

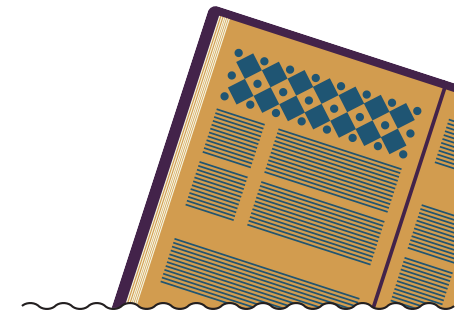

Preteen

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time
