Breaking the Ice

1. If you could have dinner with any single person either from history or still alive, who would it be and why?
2. What is your favorite Christmas Offering initiative that Rise City Church has been a part of? Why?

Getting Started

1. Brandon talks about finishing well. If you knew you were about to die, what would you do? How would you treat the people in your life?
2. What would you do if you knew you were the most important person in the world?
People could easily use their position and power to benefit themselves or to serve others. Lead your group through an honest self-examination in this direction.

Digging Deeper

1. Where are your opportunities to serve? How can you serve at church, at home, at work, in your neighborhood, in your community, etc.?
2. Jesus washed all of His disciples' feet, including Judas, who would betray Him. Who in your life feels hard to serve?
3. Peter didn't feel like he deserved to have his feet washed by Jesus and so initially resisted allowing Jesus to serve him. Where in your life do you feel like you need to allow others to serve you?

Bringing It Home

This section is a time to guide your group through how to respond to failure and temptation. This is a time to lead people toward confession, then looking to Jesus and finally, finding victory in Christ.

1. Do you feel like there are areas/places that you could or should start serving? What action are you going to take where there are opportunities to serve?
2. Earlier, we discussed people who are hard to serve for us, much like Judas may have been for Jesus. How can you be intentional about serving the "Judases" in your life?
3. What is an area in your life that you have not allowed Jesus into - to serve you, love you, heal you, or restore you? Spend some time praying for one another to receive Jesus' serving presence in those areas.
